ELECTION COMMISSION OF INDIA NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 150, 30 AND 56 OF THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ACT, 1951 (43 OF 1951) FOR THE BYE-ELECTION TO 253-ALLAGADDA ASSEMBLY CONSTITUENCY.

The following notification of the Election Commission of India, New Delhi, No. 100/AP-LA/2/2014, dated:14th October, 2014 / 22 Asvina, 1936 (Saka) is published:-

NOTIFICATION

No.100/AP-LA/2/2014: - Whereas, on the 2nd April, 2014 and 12th April, 2014, the Governor of the State of Andhra Pradesh was pleased to call upon all Assembly Constituencies in the State, including 253-Allagadda Assembly Constituency, to elect members to the Legislative Assembly of the State to constitute new Legislative Assembly of the State and, accordingly the poll to elect the member to represent 253-Allagadda Assembly Constituency was held on 7th May, 2014; and

Whereas, Smt. Bhuma Shobha Nagi Reddy, one of the contesting candidates from the said constituency expired on 24th April, 2014, i.e., before the date of poll, and by virtue of having secured the majority of valid votes polled, she was declared elected on the 16th May, 2014 posthumously; and

Whereas, the seat of Smt. Bhuma Shobha Nagi Reddy, in the Legislative Assembly of the Andhra Pradesh State, elected from 253-Allagadda Assembly Constituency, has become vacant on 16.05.2014 itself, by reason of her death; and

Whereas, a bye-election is to be held for the purpose of filling the vacancy so caused;

Whereas, the High Court of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana of Hyderabad has directed by its interim order dated 25.9.2014, that the said bye-election shall be subject to its further orders in Writ petitions No.14303 of 2014 and No.14305 of 2014;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 150, and Sections 30 and 56 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951) and subject to the above mentioned order dated 25.9.2014 of the High Court, the Election Commission of India hereby -

- (A) Calls upon the said 253-Allagadda Assembly Constituency in the State of Andhra Pradesh to elect, before the 14th November, 2014 (Friday) and in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and orders made thereunder, a person for the purpose of filling the said vacancy in the Legislative Assembly of the State; and
- (B) Appoints, with respect to the said election -
- (a) The 21st October, 2014 (Tuesday), as the last date for making nominations;
- (b) the 22nd October, 2014 (Wednesday), as the date for the scrutiny of nominations;
- (c) the 24th October, 2014 (Friday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures;
- (d) the 8th November, 2014 (Saturday), as the date, on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken;
- (e) the 14th November, 2014 (Friday), as the date before which the election shall be completed, and
- (C) Fixes the hours from 7.00 A.M. to 6.00 P.M, as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken on the date specified above for the election.
