With reference to the announcement of Biennial elections to Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council from 3 Graduates' (Srikakulam-Vizianagaram-Visakhapatnam Graduates' ; Prakasam-Nellore-Chittoor Graduates' and Kadapa-Anantapur-Kurnool Graduates') Constituencies and 2 Teachers' (Prakasam-Nellore-Chittoor Teachers' and Kadapa-Anantapur-Kurnool Teachers') Constituencies and to Telangana Legislative Council from Mahabubnagar-Ranga Reddy-Hyderabad Teachers' Constituency by the ECI, vide reference third cited, copies of the references first and second cited, wherein instructions/ orders have been issued for grant of **Special Casual Leave on the day of poll** to the Central and State Government employees, who are bonafide voters in the elections to State Legislative Councils to enable them to exercise their right of franchise, are sent herewith to the Collectors & District Election Officers of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, Kadapa, Anantapur and Kurnool districts of Andhra Pradesh State and the Collectors & District Election Officers of Mahabubnagar, Wanaparthy, Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal, Ranga Reddy, Medchal and Vikarabad districts of Telangana State and the Commissioner, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation & District Election Officer, Hyderabad. They are requested to communicate the same to all offices (both Central and State Governments) in their district to enable them to grant Special Casual Leave on the day of poll (ie., 09.03.2017) to their employees who are bonafide voters in the said constituencies.

2. With regard to the employees of private establishments, the District Election Officers are informed that there is no provision under Representation of People Act, 1951 to declare a general holiday under Negotiable Instrument Act for the elections to State Legislative Councils. Hence, a 'press announcement' (copy enclosed) has been issued by the Chief Electoral Officer requesting all the Private Managements/authorities of business,

trade, industrial undertaking or other establishments in the state to grant necessary facilities to their employees who are registered voters in any of the Graduates' Constituencies, such as permission to attend office / duty late; adjustments of shifts; short absence of duty hours or otherwise, so as to enable them to exercise their right of franchise to vote on the day of poll (ie., 09.03.2017).

3. A copy of the press announcement being issued by the Chief Electoral Officer in this regard is communicated herewith for reference. All the District Election Officers are requested to issue similar press announcement in their district.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject : Biennial elections to the State Legislative Councils from Graduates & Teachers' Constituencies - Grant of Special Casual Leave.

Guidelines regulating closure of Central Government offices in connection with elections to Lok Sabha/State Assemblies were circulated vide this Department's O.M.No.12/4/86-JCA dated 9.3.87.

2. In terms of the Election Commission of India letter No.78/94/2078 dated 13.4.94, it has now been decided that in addition to the facilities indicated in the O.M. referred to in para-1 above, all Central Government employees who are University Graduates and are bonafide voters in the elections to the State Legislative Councils from Graduates and Teachers' Constituencies may, in future, be allowed Special Casual Leave on the day of the poll to enable them to exercise their right of franchise in such elections.

3. All Ministries/Departments may bring these instructions to the notice of all attached and subordinate offices for appropriate action. Hindi version will follow.

ORDER:

The Election Commission of India in the references read above, conveyed that the Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, P.G & Pensions (Department of Personnel & Training) have allowed *Special Casual Leave* to all Central Government employees who are University Graduates and are bonafide voters in the elections to the State Legislative Councils from Graduates' and Teachers' Constituencies and requested the State Government to issue orders on similar lines. Certain representations have also been received to allow Special Casual Leave on the day of poll to the Teachers / Graduates to enable them to exercise their right to vote in the Council elections.

2. Government after careful consideration of the suggestions of Election Commission of India and also orders of the Government of India, in the Ministry of Personnel, P.G & Pensions (Department of Personnel & Training), hereby direct that the appropriate authorities under the State Government shall in future, grant ***Special Casual Leave*** on the day of poll, if the day falls on a working day to such of their employees who are bonafide voters in the elections to A.P. Legislative Council from Teachers and Graduates Constituencies to enable them to exercise their right of franchise in such elections.

As per the schedule, the Poll is to be held on 09.03.2017 (Thursday) from 8.00 AM to 6.00 PM.
