ORDER:

Under Section 28 (A) of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 the Government of Andhra Pradesh hereby designate the following Police Officers in the State of Andhra Pradesh for the purpose of Law & Order and other duties connected with conduct of the ensuing Biennial Elections to Biennial elections to Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council from 3 Graduates' (Srikakulam-Vizianagaram-Visakhapatnam Graduates' ; Prakasam-Nellore-Chittoor Graduates' and Kadapa-Anantapur-Kurnool Graduates' Constituencies) and 2 Teachers' (Prakasam-Nellore-Chittoor Teachers' and Kadapa-Anantapur-Kurnool Teachers') Constituencies scheduled to be held on 09.03.2017:

- xi) All Superintendents of Police in the districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, Kadapa, Anantapur and Kurnool
- xii) All the Sub-Divisional Police Officers connected to Biennial Elections to Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council in the districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, Kadapa, Anantapur and Kurnool
- xiii) All the Inspectors of Police connected to Biennial Elections to Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council in the districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, Kadapa, Anantapur and Kurnool

- xvi) All the Police Constables connected to Biennial Elections to Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council in the districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, Kadapa, Anantapur and Kurnool
- xvii) Any other Police Officers serving for the time being in the Police Department, who are involved in any way in election related arrangements or performing duties in connection with conduct of Biennial Elections to Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council in the districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, Kadapa, Anantapur and Kurnool scheduled to be held on 09.03.2017.

2. The above officers are deemed to be on deputation to the Election Commission of India from 13.02.2017 (Date of Notification) to 18.03.2017 (Date before which election shall be completed) or the date of declaration of result of the said election, whichever is earlier and accordingly, they shall, during that period, be subject to the control, superintendence and discipline of the Election Commission of India.

3. The Director General of Police, Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada is requested to communicate these orders to all concerned noted under para (1) above and ensure that all the instructions of the Election Commission of India as well as the Chief Electoral Officer are followed scrupulously and also to conduct the biennial elections in a free, fair and peaceful manner.
